This program is designed to assist employees in complying with California OSHA regulations and standards. In addition to the basics of OSHA compliance, Cal/OSHA Compliance will address topics of critical importance to attendees with responsibility for managing OSHA issues. For example, AB 1127's increased penalties, enforcement procedures and appeals process, as well as standards developments including ergonomics, forklifts, Log 300 injury/illness recording and reporting, lockout/tagout and injury and illness prevention.</p>
	<p>April May June</p>	<p>Environmental Crash Course*: The Environmental Crash Course has been conducted annually since 1988 to train and update business managers, company officials, attorneys and others responsible for environmental compliance on California environmental laws and regulations. There is no comparable source of information to find out about changes in state laws, regulations, policies and enforcement developments. Every important regulatory subject is covered, including relevant federal background, basic program requirements, state differences and changes effective each year.</p>
	<p>July & August</p>	<p>Accident Prevention: A seminar on risk management directly related to Cal/OSHA standards, enforcement procedures and defenses to citations, civil liability and workers comp serious & willful claims. This program includes analysis of the employer's Log 300, workers comp and other accident indicators to determine whether the employer is at risk or targeted for a Cal/OSHA inspection, especially by the dreaded High Hazard Unit. It also shows how to prevent injuries due to accidents and use of these measures to prove reasonable diligence as a defense strategy.</p> <p>Proposition 65 - Issues and Solutions: Seminars on this unique topic were conducted through 2003. They will be resumed if there is a significant change in this law or enforcement tactics that employers should be aware of.</p>
	<p>September & October</p>	<p>HAZMAT Compliance Training and Train-the-Trainer Program*: This training covers the information you need to meet current California and federal hazardous materials and hazardous waste management and training requirements. This information is presented in a format which will equip attendees to demonstrate compliance with the regulations most frequently enforced by CUPAs and Cal/OSHA. This class' unique integration of overlapping regulatory and training requirements and train-the-trainer instruction will save you time, effort and expense and equip you with the tools to provide expert, quality training to other employees. 	<p>November & December</p>	<p>Hazardous Waste Management*: This class covers the basic hazardous waste management requirements, including current updates through each legislative session, for both newly assigned and experienced managers who need to be up-to-date. The focus of this training is on California requirements for hazardous waste generators, including RCRA and non-RCRA hazardous waste.</p>
