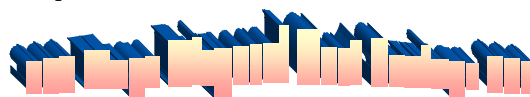

Tanks that store or treat hazardous

wastes are coming under increasing scrutiny by CUPA local inspectors directed by new DTSC and Cal-CUPA form inspection guides.

Universal waste crackdown by DTSC resulted in the arrest of 21 violators who improperly disposed of electronic waste in Los Angeles.

Permitting rules for on-site treatment of hazardous waste by generators have been amended to allow treatment of cyanide

containing waste water and bleeding treated waste water to sewers.
